Competition Information

Competition Categories: Photos will be submitted in three categories: the "Color Open/General" division, the "Nature" division and the "Monochrome" division.

Number of images: Up to four images may be submitted in each division.

Image Specifications: All images will be submitted online in JPEG format

Image Selection: All images will be judged and 29% to 35% of the submitted images will be accepted for inclusion in the catalog.

Awards: Color Open division will have two awards: Best of Show and the Bunny Solomon Best Landscape photo. The Nature division will have one award: Best of Show. The Monochrome division will have one award: Best of Show.
